

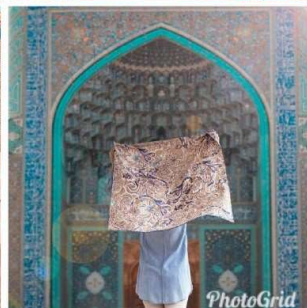
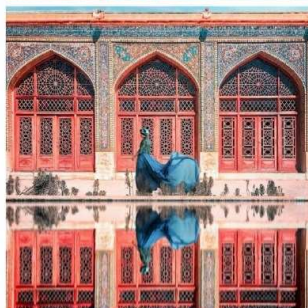


## Discover Iran; The Tourist Experience

or as the great persian poet Hafez would say: “fear is the cheapest room in the house. i'd like to see you living in better conditions”

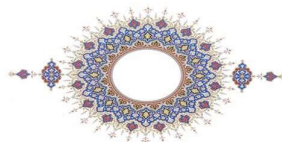

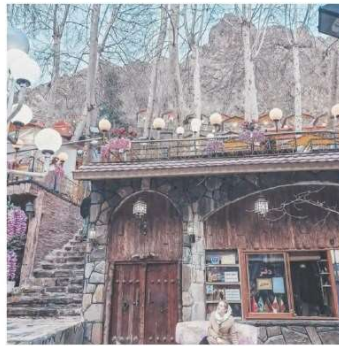
